CONTENTS UNDER PRESSURE FLAMMABLE.

Contains Hexane and Acetone. Do not use or store near heat or open flame. Do not puncture or incinerate container. Exposure to temperature above 120°F may cause bursting. If excessive inhalation, remove to fresh air immediately. If swallowed do not induce vomiting. Call doctor. Keep out of eyes. If eve or skin contact occurs, flush with plenty of water.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

FOR TEMPORARY BOND

As a pressure sensitive application, spray on surface, allow to dry several minutes, then apply with light pressure.

FOR PERMANENT BOND

Spray both surfaces evenly. Allow to dry for 1 to 2 minutes. Press together firmly and allow to set under pressure.

Always Clean Spray Tip

After use, turn can upside down and spray for 2 seconds to clear tip to prevent clogging. Always wipe off excessive buildup on tip - while it's fresh. If dried out, remove with a degreasing fluid.
